Academic Support Outline

Frank L. Madla Early College High School will provide academic labs built within the academic day to support student success and college credit attainment. These courses will be taught by academic faculty with the purpose of providing support to students either entering college courses, or students currently enrolled in college courses. Students attending Frank L. Madla Early College High School students will have access to all college support and student services provided to traditional college students. This includes, but is not limited to, Brainfuse online tutoring, Academic Learning Labs, and individual tutoring services. In order to create a collegial environment, and advocate student success, teachers will be available to students before school, after school, and by appointment during the day as needed.

The academic calendar established by the New Frontiers Public Schools district will provide days with the express purpose of student and parent conferences built into the academic calendar. Teachers will have opportunity to meet with parents. The academic counselor may establish meetings with parents to discuss degree progress, 4 year degree plans, as well as transfer plans to ensure a smooth transition to a 4 year university.
